### RULES and REGULATIONS:

1. All exhibitors must comply with General Rules and Regulations.
2. All Boer goats exhibited in 4-H classes must be the property of the exhibitor, and be registered in the individuals name as of July 1 of the current year.
3. All Market goats must be owned on or before May 31 of the current year and must be weighed and tagged by an official weigh committee at the first county weigh-in (date and time set by Superintendent).
4. Market lambs will be placed in correct class after weigh-in on Monday. In the instance that a class is deemed excessively large, it will be left to the discretion of the show chairman to revise such class to a more reasonable size.
5. One entry per exhibitor in all group classes.
6. All goats shown in Showmanship class must be fitted by the member, see the 2011 Montgomery Co. 4-H Meat Goat Club handbook.
7. All bucks entered in market classes must be castrated. Doe kids may also be entered in Market Classes.
8. Class 43: Animals entered in the Bred and Owned Class must be registered with the ABGA, for verification of bred and owned status. This includes percentage and as well as full blood animal's wethers as well as doe kids.
