RULES and REGULATIONS: Beef Cattle

1. All exhibitors are subject to the general rules and regulations and the livestock rules in addition to the particular rules listed here.
2. Bedding will be mulch. No shavings or sawdust permitted.
3. Spaces will be reserved as entries are received.
4. Tie out time: 8 pm nightly in designated areas only, following tie outs by 4-H members. Do not tie cattle on poultry fence.
5. All animals to be exhibited in Group classes must be shown in individual classes.
6. Tie out bedding will be straw. No mulch shavings or sawdust permitted.

MD HEREFORD SHOW AWARDS:

- A Premier Breeder and Premier Exhibitor will be selected at the Maryland Hereford Show.

CLASSES: Angus, Hereford and Shorthorn

- Cow and Calf-Natural:
 - Cows with natural calf at side born after Jan. 1, 2011. Calves must be registered and have papers on grounds.
 - If more than eight cows and calves are shown, the class will be divided based on the age of the cow.
 - There will be a champion and a reserve champion cow and calf. They will not show for Grand Champion Female of the open breeding show.
 - Cows must be shown at halter with natural calf at side.

- Produce of Dam: Two animals of either sex, the produce of one dam
- Breeder Best Five Head: The exhibitor must be the breeder and first owner of the animals exhibited in individual classes. The breeder and first owner must have the same member code. EXCEPTION: Cattle bred and owned by either a spouse, legal children, brothers and sisters or parents of the exhibitor may be included, provided the exhibitor is an individual or married couple identified by a single-member code.

TEXAS LONGHORN YOUTH and OPEN SHOW

Saturday, Aug. 20 at noon

ITLA Qualifying Show

- All cattle must be registered Texas Longhorn cattle.
- Include registration form with entry.
- All exhibitors and cattle must comply with ITLA show rules.
- Females over 30 months of age must have calf at side or be palpated safe in calf by veterinarian and notation made on health papers.
- No crossbred calves may be shown at sides of cows.

Youth Show Regulations

- Youth must be a member of the ITLA Youth Association.
- Must be age 18 or under as of January 1, 2011, to compete in the Youth Division.
- No adults, except for show officials, will be permitted in Pavilion.
- Dress code will be the same as for ITLA Open Classes.
- Any questions that arise concerning items not covered by these rules will be the decision of the show officials, and will be binding.

Peewee Division

Youth age 6 and under as of January 1, 2011, may exhibit one calf either sex. This is the only youth class for which adults are permitted in the ring to assist exhibitor.
