CLASSES:

8. Tandem Hitch -Two horses or mules hitched in tandem to a two-wheel cart or suitable four-wheel vehicle, no hitch wagons. \$50, 40, 30, 20
9. Sled Class - Single draft horse or mule hitched to a sled. Farm harness only. Horses may be braided, but no mane or tail decorations. \$25 , 20, 15, 10

10. Farm Team - horses or mules. Farm harness, no patent leather or scotch collars, no mane or tail decoration, no fifth wheel wagons. Appropriate dress. Individual tests will be required: \$30, 25, 20, 15
11. Antique Farm Machinery - mules or draft horses. Total money of \$100 to be divided by everyone entered. No wagons. Implement must be in good repair. Judged on manners, suitability and general appearance. All exhibitors in this class will split the sponsored money equally, minimum amount \$10 per exhibitor. Ribbons will be awarded in the Danish manner. Judge may award two or more blue (or red, etc) ribbons if more than one entry merits that placing.
12. Six-Horse Hitch: \$125, 100, 75, 50
13. Six-Mule Hitch: \$125, 100

Note: All six horse and mule teams will be exhibited separately (one at a time). They will perform at the request of the Judge (walk, trot, back, figure eight, etc.). After all have performed, the Judge will announce the placing.

14. Pleasure Driving Class Draft Horse or Mule hitched to cart or 4-wheeled vehicle. No fancy carts. No braiding. No show harness. These animals must be pure Draft; draft cross-breds and no stallions may be entered. These animals may not be shown in any other classes except under saddle. Class premiums sponsored by Melody Jamieson - \$50.00 divided equally among exhibitors.
15. Four-Horse Hitch: \$100, 75, 50, 25
16. Multiple Mule Hitch: Three or four mules hitched abreast or tandem: \$75, 60, 40
17. Unicorn Hitch: \$75, 40, 30, 20
18. Mule Team Hitch: \$30, 25, 20, 15, 10, 5
19. Team Hitch Belgium, open: \$30, 25, 20, 15, 10, 5
20. Team Hitch: Percheron, open: 30, 25, 20, 15, 10, 5
21. Team Hitch: Clydesdale/Shire (open): \$30, 25, 20, 15, 10, 5
22. Team Hitch: Registered Draft Mares: \$30, 25, 20, 15, 10, 5
23. Youth Driving Team, 8-13 yrs.: \$25, 20, 15, 10, 5
24. Youth Driving Team, 14-19 yrs.: \$25, 20, 15, 10, 5

NOTE:

- Youth may drive in any other team or multiple hitch classes. Must be accompanied by an experienced adult.
- All animals under saddle must be pure Draft Horses / Mules ONLY . NO cross breeds, and NO Stallions may be entered.

26. Draft horse or draft mule under saddle - YOUTH TO RIDE: \$20, 15, 10, 5, 5, 5, 5, 5. English, no driving bridles or bareback pads. Judged as a pleasure riding class at a walk and trot both ways of the ring. To stand quietly and back easily.
27. Draft horse under saddle - ADULT TO RIDE. Judged as class 26. Riders to be 20 years of age or older. Draft horse only: \$20, 15, 10, 5, 5, 5, 5, 5 - English
28. Youth to Ride - Western
29. Adult to Ride - Western
